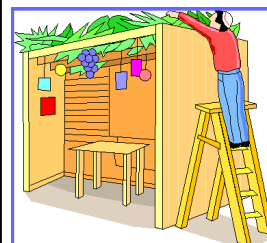
Group Teki'ah G'dolah
